RARE FIRST EDITION by JEAN-ANTOINE DE BAÏF "LES JEUX" printed in PARIS 1572. Early genuine first edition of one of the most important French poets and writers of the Renaissance. Book in excellent condition and complete, paper with very few defects, solid binding, with richly gilt decorations and titles on the spine.

- XIX Eclogues (Poems inspired by Ovid and Ariosto)
- Tragédie Antigone (Sophocles play)
- Comédie Le Brave (Plautus comedy)
- Comédie L'Eunuque (Terence comedy)

Author: Jean-Antoine de Baïf (1532–1589) was a French poet and member of the Pléiade, a group of 16th-century French poets whose principal members were Pierre de Ronsard, Joachim du Bellay and Jean-Antoine de Baïf. Baïf was born in Venice, the natural son of the scholar Lazare de Baïf (1496–1547), who was at that time French ambassador at Venice. Thanks, perhaps, to the surroundings of his childhood, he grew up an enthusiast for the fine arts, and surpassed in zeal all the leaders of the Renaissance in France.

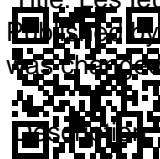
