

Book in excellent condition and complete, paper with very few defects, solid binding, with richly gilt decorations and titles on the spine.

Author: Jean-Antoine de Baïf (1532–1589) was a French poet and member of the Pléiade, a group of 16th-century French poets whose principal members were Pierre de Ronsard, Joachim du Bellay and Jean-Antoine de Baïf. Baïf was born in Venice, the natural son of the scholar Lazare de Baïf (1496–1547), who was at that time French ambassador at Venice. Thanks, perhaps, to the surroundings of his childhood, he grew up an enthusiast for the fine arts, and surpassed in zeal all the leaders of the Renaissance in France.
